Great weather and large crowds helped us raise more than \$3,700 at the Downtown Overland Park Fall Fest on September 29! **Lion Roger Claxton**, Treasurer, reported that this was the best year we've had since at least 2005, if not longer.

**Past President Chris Pucci** about mid-afternoon was describing how busy workers at the booth were. He said, "People just kept coming up in waves!"

This year at the Festival we sold out of all items with the exception of 5 cases of Coke, 3 cases of water and 3 packages of brats. All of these were sold to club members at the close of the event. We sold 1000 hot dogs, 500 brats, 21 cases of water, 24 cases of Diet Coke, 19 cases of Coke, 500 packages of potato and other chips, and uncountable amounts of coffee, ice tea and popcorn.
